Incident: Motor Vehicle Collision Involving Two Vehicles – One Person Seriously Injured
Location: State Route 211, Town of Wallkill, NY
Date/Time: April 7, 2022 / 9:30 am

On Thursday, April 7, 2022 at 9:30 am, members of this Department responded to a report of a motor vehicle collision on State Route 211 and Hidden Drive. Upon arrival Police Officers discovered that a vehicle being operated by Faith Illenberg, a 55 year old, female, Middletown, NY resident collided with a vehicle being operated by Jean Kallus, a 57 year old, female, Montgomery, NY resident. After the initial collision, both operators were trapped in their vehicles. After being extricated by members of the Mechanicstown and Montgomery Fire Departments, both were transported to Garnet Health Medical Center by Town of Wallkill Emergency Medical Services. Subsequently, both were transferred to Westchester County Medical Center, where they are being treated for serious injuries. The collision occurred as Illenberg's vehicle was travelling eastbound on State Route 211 when it collided with Kallus' vehicle, which was travelling westbound on State Route 211. Town of Wallkill Detectives, with the assistance of the New York State Police, are continuing to investigate the cause of the accident.
